

THE POKER PALACE

The investigation of your sports book complaint filed against The Poker Palace, which was reported on September 29, 2008, has been completed. The facts and circumstances of the case could not substantiate your claim of \$7,340. My decision, therefore, is The Poker Palace is not obligated to award this amount for the following reasons:

1. The 11 sports book wagering tickets you made in November and December 2007 included the limitation that wagers are void after 30 days after an event, which was printed on the reverse side of each ticket.
2. Your claim that the posted sports book house rules did not include the same limitation, that wagers are void after 30 days after an event, was not substantiated.
3. An investigation was conducted by an Enforcement agent and revealed that the same limitation was also found conspicuously posted inside the race and sports book, which was presumably posted with the same wordage and in the same location for approximately three years. Therefore, the limitation was in place at the time you made your wagers and when you attempted to cash them in, which was approximately six months after the sporting events concluded.

If you do not agree with the above decision, you have twenty (20) days from receipt of this letter to file a written request for a hearing.
